The focus is on health, a balanced lifestyle, and hygiene.

Puberty – physical and emotional changes in both girls and boys.

Year 6 have a separate session for boys and girls, when there is the opportunity for them to ask questions about issues which concern them.

Sessions will be based on School Nurse provided materials.

The fact that this topic will be covered is usually indicated in the teacher's letter to parents at the start of the relevant term. At this stage parents are also invited to look at the materials being used. Parents will have the opportunity to discuss their concerns and may withdraw their child from the sessions if they wish. The school nurse also offers parents the opportunity to meet with her and discuss the syllabus and materials.
