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Dear parent/carers,

I hope this letter finds you well and you all had a lovely half term and a well deserved rest.

What a fabulous term we had last term, ending with a wonderful week to remember in Derbyshire. Thank you all so much for your support and for letting me take your little angels away for the week, we really did have a super time and I couldn't be more proud of each and every member of the class (even Mr. King)! Please remember that our outcome is this Friday (7th June) at 2:15pm. During this time you will get the chance to hear all the children talking about their experiences, alongside seeing all of the photos and their High Ash display!

On Monday 10th June, I will launch our new topic for this term (Spectacular Science) and the children will enjoy a day of scientific experiments and even a surprise visitor too! During the term, the children will be learning about a fictional voyage and return story, followed by a set of non-fictional instructions in literacy, both connected to the importance of being healthy. Science will be linked to keeping our body and minds healthy, the environment around us, the habitat of both animals and humans and the wider water cycle. PE will be on a Thursday afternoon this term. Please make sure that your child has a named PE kit in school, including trainers. We will be going outside every week if it is dry! If your child has their ears pierced, please make sure that they are able to remove their earrings themselves or provide plasters to cover them up for their lesson. Children with long hair will need to have their hair tied up so please provide a hairband in their kit as well. It is useful if your child leaves their kit in school during the term, this also ensures they have a change of clothes option should they ever need it. Please also make sure that your child continues to come to school with a named water bottle every day. Swimming will continue to be on a Friday morning. Please make sure your child has a named swimming kit (including a swimming hat) in school for this session.

I will continue to set literacy homework on a Monday and MyMaths on a Friday. If you need any log in reminders, please do not hesitate to contact me. Children should be reading at home 3/4 times per week, this is proven to have a huge impact on their vocabulary and language skills. I know life can be busy, but please try to fill in their reading record books, even if it is just a signature, thank you.

Our outcome for this final term will be the KS2 production on the 17th and 18th July. I know the

auditions have been happening with gusto, so please do try to come along to one of the performances if you can.
