Additional mobile data

The DfE are providing internet connections through mobile data increases or 4G wireless routers for pupils who meet these criteria:

- Does not have fixed broadband at home
- Cannot afford additional data for their devices
- Is experiencing disruption to their face to face education

It is only for participating networks.

Primary School Staff testing

The Department for Education announced yesterday that primary school staff will be receiving tests to try to identify asymptomatic cases. More guidance is awaited but it is anticipated that it will not start until after the 25th January.

If this does take place, the likelihood is that more staff, and classes, will have to isolate through asymptomatic cases.

This may have an impact on the provision that we can run at school and the remote learning. **If we are unable to safely staff a class, then we will have to temporarily close the class to all children, including vulnerable and critical workers.**
