The aim of the project is to broaden the understanding of what makes a nation and explore democracy and British values.

Subject areas that will be included in our project are: Science, Geography, History, Literacy, Music, Art, DT and Maths.

During this term Literacy and Numeracy will be linked to our Topic where appropriate. Some areas covered in Literacy will be: Robinson Crusoe (diary entry), The land before time (newspaper); own island newspaper;

Our whole class guided reading text will be Holes by Louis Sachar.

Numeracy will involve consolidation and extending areas studied before, such as: ratio and proportion , geometry-position and direction, decimals, scaling and measurements.
