Dear parents/carers,

I hope you enjoyed your Easter Break!

This term, we will continue to explore what it was like growing up during the 1930s and 1940s. During this part of the term, we will explore more of the 'Everyday' lives of children during this time in history. In science, we will learn more about 'Everyday' materials and their properties. We will combine this with music, D&T and Art to include making our own musical instruments out of recycled materials, and printing!

Our PE sessions (Thursday) will continue to focus on the development of skills such as throwing, catching, controlling a ball at different speeds and in different directions and tactical gameplay. We will also have a go at some of the sporting activities the children would have learned during the 1930s and 1940s!

PSHE will include:

Families- I can identify the different members of my family, understand my relationship with each of them and know why it is important to cooperate.

Keeping Safe - exploring physical contact. I understand that there are lots of forms of physical contact within a family and that some of this is acceptable and some not.

Friends and conflict- I can identify some of the things that cause conflict with my friends.

Secrets-I understand that sometimes it is good to keep a secret and sometimes it is not good

Trust and Appreciation- I recognise and appreciate people who can help me in my family, my school and my community.

Celebrating my special relationships-I can express my appreciation for the people in my special relationships

The project outcome will be a display of all of the work completed during this project. This will take place in the school Hall on **Friday 27th May between 8:45- 9:30 am**. This should not clash with any

other class outcomes. The children will take you around the display and explain their work.

Assessments

KS1 SATS assessments will take place this term. The KS1 tests consist of:

- English reading Paper 1: combined reading prompt and answer booklet
- English reading Paper 2: reading booklet and reading answer booklet
- Mathematics Paper 1: arithmetic
- Mathematics Paper 2: reasoning

They will be administered during May 2022.
