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Dear parents/carers,

I hope you had a lovely Easter. We had a great Japan topic last term. I hope you all enjoyed seeing all of the work the children did at our Japanese exhibition.

This term, our topic will be Stone Age and learning about what life was like then. The children will develop a chronologically secure knowledge and understanding of British, local and world history, finding out what happened in the Stone Age and how it changed our world today.

We will be looking at geometry in math before moving on to problem solving and consolidation activities after Sats. In Literacy, we will be reading an overcoming the monster story and the children will learn the features of this and then write their own.

This topic will involve lots of History, Art, DT and Geography as well as a heavy focus on science.

PSHE this term we will be working on 'relationships' and the children will continue to have Mrs Shorter teaching them Spanish and RE on a Friday afternoon.

PE will continue to be on a **Wednesday** afternoon so please make sure your child comes to school in their PE kit on a Wednesday. Any children with long hair will need to have it tied up please. PE will be outside this term so please make sure your child comes to school dressed accordingly.

Our outcome for this term will be on Thursday 26th May at 2:30pm.

I will continue to set spelling homework on a Monday which will be due on the Friday of that week and Literacy and Math homework will still be alternated on a Wednesday and due in the following Wednesday. Topic homework for this term will be set this week and will be due at the end of term. I will provide the children with the date of this.

Boosters will start from Monday 25th April and will run for the first two weeks of term until the Sats tests start on Monday 9th May.

On Tuesday 26th April from 12pm to 3pm we have a trip into Oxford for our Junior Citizenship trip. Year 6 do this every year and learn all sorts of interesting things. The trip is fully paid for but I do ask that all children are sent to school with a packed lunch on this day so we can have an early lunch to make it into Oxford on time. The children will need to wear school uniform as normal on this day and come to school at the normal start time, we will be back by 3:15pm.

I look forward to another great term with the year 6's.
